HOW TO READ THE BIBLE

2Tim 2:15

Do your best to present yourself to God as a tried-and-true worker who isn't ashamed to teach the word of truth correctly.

1. Read daily. Decide on a time of the day that is suitable and comfortable for you.
2. Set a set time for reading of at least 15 minutes if you are really serious with God.
3. Decide on a regular place, No TV music or noise that can distract you from talking to God.
4. Have a pen at hand. If you read a interesting verse or the Holy Spirit tell you something then write it down.
5. Read the Bible for personal edification. It has the basic inspiration and guidance of how we must live. It is the Bread of life. We must also pray that He give us the message for that day.
6. Keep everyday a spiritual dairy. This is for writing down the thoughts you get from God while you reading.



WHAT BIBLE STUDY CAN DO FOR YOU

- It can make you a stronger Christian:
 - 1 Joh 2:14 *"I've written to you, children,I've written to you, young people, because you are strong and God's word lives in you. You have won the victory over the evil one."*
- It CONFIRMS your salvation:
 - 1Joh 5:13 *"I've written this to those who believe in the Son of God so that they will know that they have eternal life."*
 - 1Cor 1:21 *"For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know God, God decided through the nonsense of our preaching to save those who believe."*
- It gives us confidence and power in prayer:
 - 1John 5:14 *And this is the confidence that we have in him: if we ask for anything according to his will, he listens to us.*
 - 1John 5:15 *And if we know that he listens to our requests, we can be sure that we have what we ask him for.*
 - John 15:7 *If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.*
- Cleansing of sins:
 - John 15:3 *Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.*
 - John 17:17 *"Use the truth to make them holy. Your words are truth.*
 - HOW DO WE KNOW OUR SIN IS FORGIVEN? 1Joh 1:9 *God is faithful and reliable. If we confess our sins, he forgives them and cleanses us from everything we've done wrong.*
- It guide us through the daily decisions we have to MAKE:
 - Psalm 119:105 *Your word is a lamp for my feet and a light for my path.*
 - Luke 11:28 *Jesus replied, "Rather, how blessed are those who hear and obey God's word." The more you fill yourself with the word the more you clear is the path*

WHAT BIBLE STUDY CAN DO FOR YOU-

- It will give you peace:
 - *John 16:33 I've told you all this so that trusting me, you will be unshakable and assured, deeply at peace. In this godless world you will continue to experience difficulties. But take heart! I've conquered the world."*
 - *Col 3:15 Let the peace of Christ also rule in your hearts, to which you were called in one body, and be thankful. (with His crucifixion)*
 - Peace does not come by itself, we must fill our hearts with it! By filling our thoughts with the promises / faithfulness of God and the principles of His Word. By reading His Word !
- It will give you joy:
 - *John 15:11 I have told you this so that you will be as joyful as I am, and your joy will be complete.*
- You can speak about your faith more clearly:
 - *1Pe 3:15 Through thick and thin, keep your hearts at attention, in adoration before Christ, your Master. Be ready to speak up and tell anyone who asks why you're living the way you are, and always with the utmost courtesy. I never had the chance to share my faith to any one*
- It ensures SUCCESS:
 - *Jos 1:8 And don't for a minute let this Book of The Revelation be out of mind. Ponder and meditate on it day and night, making sure you practice everything written in it. Then you'll get where you're going; then you'll succeed.*
 - *Psalms 1:1-3 Blessed is the person who does not follow the advice of wicked people, take the path of sinners, or join the company of mockers. Rather, he delights in the teachings of the LORD and reflects on his teachings day and night. He is like a tree planted beside streams- a tree that produces fruit in season and whose leaves do not wither. He succeeds in everything he does.*



1 JOHN 1

1. Let some of your friends, brothers, or children read a verse.
2. Discover what verses they enjoy and what resonates with them

1 John 1:4

And we write *these things* to you so that your *joy* may be full.

- What is these things ? - *Word of God*
- Your joy - Who 's joy is he talking about? - *All Christians*
- What is joy? - *God 's Word says I/ me can have joy. How can we find it?*
- Will God's Word lie? *No!*

The verses should be presented in chunks like this, and you should discuss it and pray about it at the end. Dissect every verse and ponder on it. Don't just read it and move on. Thank God or ask God to help you to believe His Word when it says so.

- Consider one of the Bible's books
- Read through it - verse by verse (take your time)
- read it again and mark your favorite passages on it (ask questions about the verse)
- then pray the verses (use it in your daily life, to encourage)
- memorize it
- start with new book all over again.
